No t-shirts or baggy clothes. No costumes. **BRING ALL SHOES!**

*Anyone NOT in attendance will NOT be allowed to participate in Revue.*

**\*\*\*Only one parent/guardian per dancer will be allowed in the auditorium\*\*\***

**Everyone in the auditorium must have a DGI wristband to enter.**

8:00 AM: Arrive at Heymann Center <b>in first costume</b>
8:30 AM: Awards
9:00 AM: Dress Rehearsal

- You may leave Dress Rehearsal after your dancer's last number unless specified by DGI Staff.
- All hair and makeup **MUST** be fixed correctly for Dress Rehearsal as indicated on Costume Sheet.
- Your dancer **IS** allowed to be in costume in the auditorium for Dress Rehearsal, **but absolutely no costumes or parts of a costume are allowed in the auditorium for Dance Revue.**
- The following Awards will be given out on SATURDAY prior to Dress Rehearsal, **IN THEIR FIRST COSTUME:**
  - 3rd, 5th, 7th, 9th, 11th, 13th, 15th Year
  - Perfect Attendance
  - Hardest Worker (chosen by staff)
  - Full Out Award (chosen by staff)
  - Brightside Award (chosen by staff)
- Graduate Awards will take place on stage at 5:30 PM on Saturday prior to the Show.

# **DANCE REVUE**

**Saturday, June 22 - 6:00 PM**

**Heymann Performing Arts Center**

**Dancers in the first 4 numbers of the show should arrive backstage FULLY DRESSED IN COSTUME at least 30 minutes prior to show time.**

**\*\*\*ABSOLUTELY NO COSTUMES OR PARTS OF A COSTUME IN THE AUDITORIUM!!!!**

**NO, YOU CANNOT WEAR A ROBE OR CLOTHES OVER YOUR COSTUME IN THE AUDITORIUM!!!!\*\***

- Any **additional** tickets (beyond your family's 4 tickets) to be purchased will be \$20.
- Line up in the Ballroom 3 numbers before your own number for Dress Rehearsal and Dance Revue. DGI Staff will be lining kids up. **WE WILL NOT HOLD A NUMBER IF YOUR DANCER IS LATE!**
- If your dancer will be in the audience at any time, she DOES need a ticket.
- ANYONE Ages 2+ needs a ticket to the show if they plan to be in the auditorium.
- Absolutely no parents or volunteers are allowed in the backstage area. Do not be offended if someone on DGI Staff asks you to move. They are following the directions of Lainey & Michala.
- Absolutely no panties allowed under costumes!!!
- The Revue Lineup will be sent out at a later date.
- Curtain Call will take place following the Finale Production. Please have your dancer backstage 2 numbers prior to line up. This is optional but encouraged. You will be notified by your teacher regarding what costume to be in.

## **DRESSING ROOMS**

- Each class will be assigned a designated area/room to change in for Revue. When you enter the backstage area, there will be signs directing you to your assigned area.
- If your dancer is in the Ballroom area, tents are allowed. Please just respect the given space and keep your items together. **Please also kindly pick up your trash when you exit.**

## **FOOD**

- No food or drink is allowed inside the Auditorium. Food IS allowed in the dressing rooms.

## **BACKSTAGE PASSES**

- Each family will receive one Backstage Pass wristband for the mom or individual dressing the dancer. This wristband will serve as a backstage pass which allows you to enter and re-enter the stage door only. This Backstage Pass is **NOT** equivalent to a Revue Ticket.
- No brothers, sisters, friends, etc are allowed backstage.
- No dads or male guardians are allowed backstage/in dressing rooms.

## **REVUE HINTS**

- Follow all instructions of Stage Crew and Dance Graphics Staff. If you have any questions, ask them. If they do not know the answer to your question, they will be sure to find out for you.
- Be on time
- Have all personal belongings clearly labeled with dancer's name
- Stay in designated dressing room
- Absolutely NO PANTIES under your tights or costume.
- Absolutely NO jewelry on stage, unless part of your costume.
- Wear more browns/neutrals in your eyeshadow to enhance the eyes. This will make the eyes stand out. NO purples or blues - they are too bright with the stage lights.

## **OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

### **ONLINE PRE-REGISTRATION DEADLINE: JUNE 22**

- Pre-registration for the 2024-2025 dance year will be done online. Those registering online and paying by June 22 will reserve space for next year and save \$10 on registration.
- In order to register go to [www.dancegraphicsinc.com](http://www.dancegraphicsinc.com), click Customer Portal Login, login to your account, click Find Classes, click 2024-2025 Pre-Registration, click Enroll In This Class, select student. The \$70 fee will be added to your online account. The fee to register is \$80 after June 22.

### **REVUE SEAT SELECTIONS + EXTRA TICKETS: MAY 29-31**

- Each family will receive 4 tickets included in your revue fee. However, there is a \$3.00 per ticket facility fee that we can not waive.
- All ticket distributions & sales will be done **ONLINE**. Dance Graphics will **not** be managing any seat selections or ticket sales.
- You have a dedicated date for you to log online to select your 4 free tickets as well as purchase any extra tickets you may need. You will only be allowed to purchase UP TO 8 tickets at this time.
  - When you check out the 4 free tickets will not charge you a ticketing fee; ***it will only charge the \$3.00 facility fee plus the cost of your additional tickets.***
- ***We will send out emails to each class with their dedicated date for ticket selection.*** The online process will be linked to your email address. You will only be able to log in with the email address we have on file for you. Ticket sales will open by **SENIORITY!**
- The price per additional ticket (beyond your included 4) will be \$20. This fee will encompass all fees & taxes.
- Tickets will go on sale to the public on June 5th. You will be able to reserve additional tickets beyond the allotted 8 at this time.
- EVERYONE must have a ticket to enter & exit the theater at any time. Your ticket will be scanned to enter & exit the auditorium every time you enter & exit. The doors NEAREST THE FRONT of the building will be used to exit and re-enter during the show (Townhouse side opposite the hospital).
- If you or your dancer plans to be in the audience at any time during the Revue, you will need a ticket to enter. Anyone Ages 2+ needs a ticket to sit in the auditorium.

### **YEAR-END ACCOUNT BALANCES**

- All accounts must be paid in full by May 10. A \$15 late fee will be added on May 11.
- If you have an outstanding balance when Ticket Sales open online, you will **NOT** be able to purchase tickets until your balance is paid.
- If you have an outstanding balance the week of Revue, your dancer will **NOT** be allowed to participate in Revue. No exceptions.

### **WEEK OF JUNE 17-21**

- The following classes will have regularly scheduled class at the studio:
  - Itty Bitty A (M 5:15)
  - Itty Bitty B (T 4:00)
  - Primary I (M 4:05)
  - Primary II (Tu 4:50)
  - Intermediate I (W 4:30)
  - Intermediate II (W 5:30)

- The remaining classes may have extra mandatory rehearsals throughout the month of June and/or will be needed at the Heymann. Check BAND.

**AWARD CORRECTIONS (Pink Attachment)**

- Dancers receive awards starting with three years and every odd year thereafter. A list of awards for the dance revue is attached (Attachment 1 - pink). If we have made any errors, please notify us by Thursday, April 11. All awards will be handed out at 8:30am on Saturday, June 22 before Dress Rehearsal. Your dancer will need to be dressed in her first costume to receive her award.

**PICTURES: APRIL 19 - 21 (Green Attachment)**

- A group picture will be taken in every costume. **Bring all costumes to picture day.** See the attached Picture Schedule for more information. Souvenir and individual program pictures will also be taken at your scheduled picture time.
- **NO GLITTER! - THE FLASH REFLECTS ON GLITTER AND YOUR CHILD MAY HAVE WHITE SPOTS.**

**PROGRAM PICTURE FORM: DUE APRIL 11TH. (Orange Attachment - Left Side)**

- If you plan to purchase pictures to be placed in the revue program, please return the *Program Picture Order Form* along with your payment to Dance Graphics by Thursday, April 11. Things go much smoother when we know ahead of time who needs to take program pictures.

**REVUE T-SHIRT ORDER FORM: DUE APRIL 11TH. (Yellow Attachment)**

- Every student will receive a revue t-shirt as part of your revue fee. Please return the attached Revue T-Shirt order form with your child's size by Thursday, April 11th. You may order extra t-shirts at a cost of \$15 per shirt.

**REVUE VIDEO: 2024**

- Each family will receive a downloadable copy of the Show as part of your Revue Fee. Links will be available late August/early September. We are no longer offering DVDs.

**PROGRAMS**

- Programs will be distributed June 19-21 at the Heymann Center. Come to the first row of the Auditorium to check in and pick yours up. One program per family is included in your Revue Fee.
- Additional programs will be available to purchase for \$10.
